



Dear students.

HOW THE COLLEGE WAS BORN AND BROUGHT UP

AI-Ammen Memorial Minority College is a notably noble achievement of the AI -Ameen Memorial Society for Education & Health Programme. It was founded in the year 2004. The College is a brain - child of its founder, Late Prof. Md. Roushan Ali, a patron of letters, a farsighted and noble hearted philanthropist. The impediment of his old age did not stand on his way to till his demise to offer encouragement and valuable suggestions every now and then to the founder Secretary of the College Prof. Dr. Nurul Haque to bring it to its full flagged state.

With an aim to imparting education (Higher Education) among the educationally backward minorities of West Bengal but not to the exclusion of the students of other communities, the Society humbly prayed to the Govt. of West Bengal for according necessary permission to the establishment of a Minority College under the **Article 30 of the Constitution**. The state Govt. after necessary verification and with the kind recommendation of the Hon'ble **National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions,** New Delhi, kindly accorded requisite permission to the establishment of the College with Minority status vide W.B. Govt. Order No. 421 -Edn(CS)/4C-50/05, dated 26/04/2007. Subsequently the Minority Status Certificate was also issued by the NEMEI in 2008

We are very much happy to apprise that AI-Ameen Memorial Minority College is the **first Muslim Minority General Degree College of WestBengal**. **It is affiliated to the University of Calcutta**. It is a co-educational institution for higher learning. The College was included Under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956, in 2008 and Under Section 12B of the same act in 2018.

The college was granted affiliation by the University in the academic session 2007 - 08 and subjects like Arabic (Hons.), Bengali (Hons.) and Arabic (General), Bengali (General), English (General), History(General), Political Science (General) and Philosophy (General) were offered.

We are grateful to the University of Calcutta for kindly granting extension of affiliation to subjects like **English (Hons.)**, **Islamic History & Culture (Hons.)** and **Education (General)** to the college from the academic session 2008-09.

In 2009-10 Session the college has further obtained affiliation in **Philosophy (Hons.), History (Hons.) and Urdu (Gen)**

The College was included in the year 2012 under the West Bengal colleges (Payment of Salaries) Act, 1978. We are very grateful to the State Government.

LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

The College is located at Jogibattala, Baruipur, South 24 Parganas (Kolkata - 700145), West Bengal, just five minutes away from Baruipur Railway Station and one minute away from Jogibattala Bus Stand on the Baruipur-Garia Bus Route.

Applicability of the Regulations

- 3. These regulatons shall be applicable to:
- a. The students who are taking admission to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Mus. (Honours/General) Course fro m the academic session 2020-21.
- b. The students who were admited in earlier sessions but did not enroll for B.A./B.Sc./B.Mus. (Honours /General) Part I Examinations up to 2018.
- c. The students who were admited in earlier sessions and enrolled for B.A./B.Sc./B.Mus. (H onours/General Part I Examinatons but did not appear in Part I Examinatons up to 2018.
- d. The students who were admited in earlier sessions and appeared in B.A./B.Sc./B.Mus.(Honours/General) Part I Examinatons in 2018 or earlier shall connnue to be guided by the existing Regulations of Annual System.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS

4(a). A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examinaton is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3 year (six semesters) B.A. (Honours / General) Course of Studies provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100 and fulfills the condiitio as laid down in **Clauses 5**.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocation I examinaaon conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocatonal Educaati and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) 1st year Course of Studies taking the subjects under Humanites Division only.

However, no candidate shall be allowed admission afer a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examinaton.

Explanaton: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculaang five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examinaton.

- **4(b).** Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinaton or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and Nation | Insstitu | of Open Schooling) need not require to submit Migratio Certficate for geeng Registraction under this University.
- **5.** For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A.(Honours / General) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top -four subjects in or der of marks secured by a candidate. Marks in compulsory Environmental EducationStudies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an electve subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

(a). A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:

- i. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examinatio [in case of B.Mus. (Hons.) 45% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject Music, in the previous qualifying examinatin] Or
- ii. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examinatin [in case of B.Mus. (Hons.) 50% marks in the subject Music at the previous qualifying examinaton.] Or
- iii. 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examinaton provided all other clauses are saatis fied [in case of B.Mus. (Hons.) 45% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject Music in the pre-qualifying examination. Candidates shall be admitted on the basis of the Admission Test to be conducted by the College Authority co ncerned.]
- (b). Candidates belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examinaton, as the case may be.

6. Atendance

- 6.1. A student atten ing at least 75% of the total number of classes* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to fulfilment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.
- 6.2. A student attending at least 60% but less than 75% of the total number of classes* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinatons subject to the payment of prescribed condo naton fees and fulfilment of other conditions laid down in the regulazions.
- 6.3. A student atten ing less than 60% of the total number of classes* held shall not be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinatons and he /she has to pursue admission to the same Semester in the very next year for attending the classes and appearing at the said Semester Examinatio .
- *Such atendance will be calculated from the date of commencement of classes or the date of admission, whichever is later.

7. Outline of Choice Based Credit System

A) Core Course (CC): A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.

Modalities of selecting CC by a student of Honours/ General programme shall be as follows:

- a) In case of B.A. Honours programme a student shall have to study 14 Core courses of the Honours Subject as specified for each of the 6 semesters.
- b) In case of B.A. General programme a student shall have to study 4 Core Courses of each of the 2 chosen subjects as specified for each of the first 4 Semesters. In addidit 4 Core Courses to be studied; two courses each from two language subjects: LCC1 English & LCC2 MIL (Bengali/Hindi/Urdu) /Alternatve English as specified for each of the last 4 semesters.
- **B)** Electiv Course: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or sup portive to the discipline/subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elelcve Course.
- i) Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course: Elective courses which may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Eleecve. This course is to advance knowledge and skill in the core course domain.
- **ii) Generic Elective(GE) Course :** An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intenton to seek wide exposure, is called Generic Ellecve.

Modalities of selectng GE by a student of Honours/ General programme shall be as follows:

- a) In case of B.A. Honours programme, a student shall have to choose 4 Generic Electie papers strictly from 2 subjects of choice taking exactly two courses from each subject as specified for first 4 semesters.
- b) In case of B.A. General programme, a student shall have to choose 2 Generic Electve papers strictly from one partcular subject [which will be different from the core subjects including the Core Languages (LCC1 & LCC2)] as specified for the 1st and 2nd semester.
- **C) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) :** The Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).
- a) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): AECC courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. These are mandatory for all disciplines.
- i) AECC1 : Communicatve English / MIL(Bengali/Hindi/Urdu);
- ii) AECC2: Environmental Studies.
- **b) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):** These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and are aimed at providing competencies, skills, etc.

Tutorial: Every Core, Discipline Specific and Generic Electe Course shall have a PrPracal/ Tutorial component. Wherever there is a practical, there will be no Tutorial and vice versa.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION / ENROLMENT OF STUDENTS & DISCIPLINARYACTIONS

Admission of students is liable to be cancelled at any stage with the discovery of nonfulfilment of eligibility criteria, error in information misconduct, indiscipline and violaaon of rules. The College shall not be held responsible for cancellaton of a dmission.

Strong disciplinary actons like suspension, expulsion or issuance of transfer may be taken against a student for his such actons, or torts, that may damage the spirit and image of the College, or break of peace and tranquillity or discipline of the College.

If any student simultaneously pursues similar courses in any other instituti during his/her study in this College, his admission / registratio of this College shall be cancelled.

A student who shall be found Reported Against in any Exam ination of the University shall be expelled from the College. If any student is found to be misbehaving or involved in such actions that are wrought with evil intentions/ulterior political m myes to damage the image of the College or pollute its environme int, he/she shall be expelled from the College.

If any student fails consecutiely for two years in the same subject (Hons/subsidiary), he/she may be issued transfer from the College.

Or, any such acton(s) by the student, that be deemed by the College au thority as sufficient cause for expulsion/transfer of the student, he/she shall be expelled/transferred.

An undertaking shall be obtained from the student on the ground that he/she shall abide by the rules of the College.

Name of a student may be struck off the Rolls of the College, if his/her number of aatten nce falls shorter than what is expected, through review at a regular interval of three months. He/she may be debarred from the University examinatons if his/her aatten nce is below 75%, or he/she s hall be considered discollegiate as per the University Rules.

RULES FOR STUDENTS AND GUARDIANS

CLASSES AND ATTENDANCE: As per rules of the University of Calcuta, a student must aaend a minimum of 75% of the total number of lectures delivered plus tutorial in each subject in order to become a regular student
